Submit an abstract (≤300 words) in Word MS format, (Times New Roman font) The format should include:

- **Title:** Capitalized, Bold, Font size 14.
- **Authors & Affiliation:** Bold, Font size 12 (Vancouver style), including institution address and email.
- **Corresponding author:** Marked with an asterisk. (*)
- **Abstract body:** Must include Introduction, Aim & Objectives, Material & Methods, Observations, Result and Conclusion
- **Keywords:** Max 5 words, Font size 12
- **Text:** Justified, 1.5 line spacing, Left margin 2", Right margin 1"

A Camera-ready abstract in English in A4 size page in above prescribed format should be submitted online latest by 18th April 2026 via E-mail conferenceasmc@gmail.com. The poster size should be 3ft x 4ft & E-poster should be limited to 1 slide. Maximum time limit for presentation will be for 5 mins. & 2 mins. for discussion. Paper & Poster presentations are subject to approval by scientific review committee.
